**ROAD WORKS AFFECTING BARTON ROAD  
FROM 9 OCTOBER TO MARCH 2024.**

Dear Owner/Occupier,

I am writing to you to let you know that we will soon start work on the junction of Barton Road and Grantchester Road as part of the Haslingfield Greenway from as early as Monday 9 October 2023 – targeting completion by March 2024, subject to final arrangements being confirmed.

This part of the Haslingfield Greenway will be required, whether the section through Grantchester proceeds or not.

**What is being done?**

As part of the Greater Cambridge Greenways programme, we will be providing an improved and more direct crossing facility for pedestrians and cyclists at this location, in addition to improved cycle paths and footways for users around the crossing. . There will be associated drainage, traffic signal upgrades, landscaping (including additional trees and planting) and a full resurfacing of the carriageway.

**When and what works are happening?**

Subject to final arrangements being made, our contractors, Milestone Infrastructure, will be working on the junction for approximately eighteen weeks from 9 October 2023 – March 2024. Advanced warning signage will be installed on the road network two weeks in advance of the works.

No works will be undertaken during December for the Christmas period 4 December 2023 – 5 January 2024.

During the works there will be four-way temporary traffic lights (including Wolfson College) on the Barton Road/Grantchester Road junction. The traffic management hours will be restricted to 09:30-15:30, where possible, work will continue outside of these hours for works that do not require traffic lights. Working hours will be 07:30-17:00, Monday - Friday.

As the works involve reconstruction of the existing cycleway/footway, and signal controlled crossing point; footway closures will be required. Pedestrian and cyclist diversion routes through the works will be implemented and there will be temporary controlled pedestrian crossing points where required.

At the end of the works there will be a full night time road closure in place for carriageway resurfacing and associated works that include high friction surfacing and road marking . Closures for Barton Road and Grantchester Road are required between the hours of 20:00 – 06:00 Monday – Friday for a period of two weeks. Further advance warning signs will be installed ahead of this period. Footway routes will remain open for cyclists and pedestrians, and approved diversion routes will be in place for all motorists. We know the works at the Barton Road and Grantchester Road junction will affect residents, colleges and businesses, as well as people travelling in the area, and we would like to apologise for any inconvenience that might be caused. We are working alongside our contractors, Milestone Infrastructure, to minimise disruption as much as possible. When complete, the works will help to make travel in Cambridge safer and more sustainable.
